

Our Tithes and Offerings

Because of the pandemic, for the past 18 months you have continued to support the ministries of our church by giving online, via the US Mail, or by using the box in the narthex. We know, however, that it can be very meaningful to offer your gifts to God during our worship time together on Sunday morning. Therefore, beginning this Sunday, **August 8th**, there will be special offertory music during which you may bring your offering to the altar. The offering plates will not be passed through the congregation at this time in order to limit the spread of germs. Pastor Ben will give you a reminder and directions on Sunday, and we invite you to share your gifts in person at that time. You may, of course, continue to give as you have been doing during the pandemic.

2021 Deacon Nomination and Election Process

Our church needs to provide up to three (3) Deacon positions for the new church year. Each person elected will be expected to serve a three-year term (October 2021 thru September 2024).
