# Discussion

- Why do you think James said that faith without actions is worth nothing (v14)?
- What can we do to help those in need?

## **Going Deeper**

• Do you think you treat people differently because of how they look or dress? What can we do to see people through God's eyes?

#### **Caring Challenge**

Why not make your own 'caring chart' with a list of different caring activities.

Give each person in the family a column and see how many times they can demonstrate care for others this week.

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#### Family Fun Together

Who am I?: Players take turns sitting in the middle of the group with their eyes closed, a leader points to another player in the circle and they must say "Who am I?" but disguising their voice. The player in the middle must then guess who the person speaking was.

Follow the leader: Just as the disciples followed Jesus, we can follow Him today and live as examples for others to follow. Take turns being the leader. Everybody else should copy and follow the leader's example. You could talk together about what makes a good leader.



#### A question for adults to ask children

How many different ways can you think of that we can care for others?

We can show kindness to others in our words and our actions. Sharing what we have with those who have needs.


#### A question for children to ask adults

You could also spend some time praying for items you need or for those in need around the world.




Write or draw a way you can show your faith.
