

"The Worship of the Golden Calf"

Exodus 32:1-20

Emphasis on v. 2-5, 11-12, 19-20


### **Questions for Further Reflection:**

When it gets hard to see God, sometimes people panic. Why would Aaron go along with the people's desire? What are some ways we can connect with God even when it is difficult to see God?
