

"Wait, What?"

Jonah 3:1-10

Emphasis on verses 4-5, 9

Questions for Further Reflection:

This passage tells a shocking story of repentance and faithfulness. How do the Ninevites react to their call from God? How is that different from Jonah's reaction? How can those differences shape our faith?
